➤ **CBC Spouses Heineken USA Performing Arts Scholarships**

Description: The performing arts include drama, music, dance, opera, marching bands and other musical ensembles.

Amount: CBCF will award up to \$3,000 for each award

Eligibility:

- U.S. citizen or permanent U.S. resident
- Currently/planning to be enrolled in the upcoming academic year as a full-time **undergraduate student** (students pursuing a graduate degree in the fall are ineligible)
- Have a minimum 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Pursuing a major and career in a performing art
- Exhibit leadership ability and participate in community service activities.

➤ **CBC Spouses Visual Arts Scholarship**

Description: The visual arts include architecture, ceramics, drawing, fashion, graphic design, illustration, interior design, painting, photography, sketching, video production and other visual arts.

Amount: CBCF will award up to \$3,000 for each award

Eligibility:

- U.S. citizen or permanent U.S. resident
- Currently/planning to be enrolled in the upcoming academic year as a full-time **undergraduate student** (students pursuing a graduate degree in the fall are ineligible)
- Have a minimum 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Be pursuing a major and career in a visual art
- Exhibit leadership and community service.

➤ **CBC Spouses Education Scholarship**

Description: This award is for student of all majors who are preparing to pursue or are currently pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree full-time at a U.S. accredited college or university.

Amount: Varies

Eligibility:

- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent U.S. resident.
- Currently/planning to be enrolled in the upcoming academic year as a full-time undergraduate or graduate student.
- Have a minimum 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
- Exhibit leadership ability and participate in community service activities.

➤ **CBCF Summer Congressional Internship Program**

Description: This intensive nine-week summer program offers the opportunity for college students from across the nation to learn about the legislative process, leadership and careers in the policy making process. Interns work in the Congressional Black Caucus members offices, attend professional development events, and participate in leadership development projects.

Amount: Housing and Stipend

Eligibility:

- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent U.S. resident or have permit to work in the U.S.
- Students must be at least a college sophomore at the time of the application. Recent graduates are eligible as long as they have not yet started post-graduate studies and have graduated no more than a year from the internship program start date.
- Have a minimum 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
- Students must have a demonstrated interest in public service, governance, and the policy-making process.

➤ **CBCF Pathways to the C-Suite Internship Program**

Description: The new Pathways to the C-Suite Internship Program partners undergraduate and post-graduate African-American students with some of the nation's top executives in private companies. Interns interact with senior-level business leaders, explore multifaceted business challenges, and build skills to prepare them for careers in corporate America.

Amount: \$0.00

Eligibility:

- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent U.S. resident or have permit to work in the U.S.
- Students must be at least a college sophomore at the time of the application. Recent graduates are eligible as long as they have not yet started post-graduate studies and have graduated no more than a year from the internship program start date.
- Have a minimum 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
- Students must be at least 21 years of age.
- Students must have a demonstrated interest in public service, governance, and the policy-making process.
